

# R.I.D.E.R.S. Clinic Weekend – September 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021

## Hants County Exhibition grounds in Windsor, N.S.

**R.I.D.E.R.S.** will be holding a Dressage coaching opportunity/test riding weekend on **September 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021** at the **Hants County Exhibition grounds in Windsor, N.S.**

On **Saturday** you will be able to ride on your own or with your Coach in a reserved time slot in the main arena. The dressage ring will be in place, and time allotted will be 30 minutes. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, and will be limited to 22 time slots. You will be able to warm up in the Mary Henry arena prior to your session.

Cost per time slot will be **\$30** for R.I.D.E.R.S. members and **\$40** for non-members.

On **Sunday**, Susan Fraser will act as judge in a test riding clinic. Riders will ride a test of their choice. It will be scored, then the judge will have a discussion with the rider on areas where performance could be improved. The same test will be ridden and scored again, with an eye to showing improvement. Each session will be limited to 20 minutes, and there will be a limit of 22 sessions.

Cost per test will be **\$30** for R.I.D.E.R.S. members, and **\$40** for non-members.

**NSEF (or Provincial membership) is mandatory.**

**Proof of horses' vaccination against influenza, Rhinovirus and Strangles are mandatory.**

A rider may participate on one or both days, with preference on Sunday given to those who ride on Saturday. Auditors (considered authorized personnel) will be able to attend at a cost of **\$15** for each day, and practice social distancing in the stands.

There will be no warm-up available in the main ring on Friday.

Stabling will be available from Friday afternoon through Sunday at **\$30** per day.

**Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.** Therefore, we suggest getting your registration in early to avoid disappointment.

**Registration deadline** will be **August 30<sup>th</sup> – 6pm.** Cancellations after August 30<sup>th</sup> will be non-refundable.

### **Covid19 Protocol are required by Hants County Exhibition management:**

- The clinic is closed to the general public and is open to authorized personnel related to the clinic only.
- Exhibitors or associated persons must stay home if displaying signs of fever and a cough, or symptoms of Covid19.
- Everyone must sign in at the show office, one person at a time, respecting social distancing.
- Covid19 Health declaration waivers must be signed by exhibitors and associated persons on **both** Saturday and Sunday.
- Stabling access will be limited to rider and one helper (coach, parent, groom)
- Wheelbarrows, forks, etc. must not be shared outside of bubbles.
- Chairs will not be allowed in barn aisles.
- Hands should be washed a minimum of every 30 mins. In lieu of hand washing, please use sanitizer.
